An organisation-wide framework for embedding equality and human rights into contract specifications.

This template has been adapted from the Equality Challenge Unit's <u>Equality</u> <u>Through Procurement in Further and Higher Education</u>. It should be tailored to your specific contracts – appropriately and proportionately.

Eliminating unlawful discrimination and abuse	 Require compliance with equality and human rights legislation Require contractor's employees to be aware of and understand the contracting organisation's equality and human rights policy Require contractor's employees to be trained on equality, disparate and human rights and human rights.
Advancing equality and rights	 diversity and human rights - or to attend training Require details of how the needs and rights of all users will be met Include details of demographics and/or specific needs to be met Require consultation with users to determine needs and review provision Require monitoring of users and contracted staff (where proportionate to the contract)
Fostering good relations	 Require positive action for underrepresented groups Require appropriate action Require appropriate monitoring
Organisation's equality and human rights work	 Include details of the contracting organisation's equality and human rights objectives to be met and ask for details of how the contractor will meet these Require appropriate monitoring and reporting (where proportionate to the contract)
